IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS

1. Parents are requested to deposit the school fee on or before the dates mentioned below, otherwise the school administration will be constrained to deny admission / attendance to your ward after the limit of late fee expires :-

Dates for payment of fee :-

1st Installment - 01 April 2025 to 10 April 2025

2nd Installment - 05 June 2025 to 22 June 2025

3rd Installment - 25 October 2025 to 01 November 2025

2. Late payment of fee will attract a fine of Rs 100/- per day to a maximum of Rs 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) after which your ward will be suspended from the school.

3. Ramdandees are required to report back after short and long breaks (outpass) strictly as per date and time specified in the conspectus for their class. Those reporting late will attract a fine as specified below :-

(a) First time fine @ Rs. 250/- for the first day and Rs. 500/- per day for subsequent days.

(b) Second time fine @ Rs. 500/- per day.

(c) Third time fine @ Rs. 500/- per day and disciplinary action will be initiated.

4. Ramdandee coming **late from breaks** will report to Administrative Office strictly **on a working day only between 10 am to 5 pm**. Reporting on a Sunday / holiday or after the given hours will not be entertained.

5. Ramdandees are allowed three day leave in each term. However, leave should be applied only for **exceptional reasons**. The management reserves the right of sanctioning leave.

6. Parents who have had the leave sanctioned for their ward should collect him between 3 pm to 5 pm from Monday to Friday and between 12 pm to 2 pm on Saturday. Ramdandee will not be permitted to leave the premises after the given timings.

7. Ramdandees coming back from leave will report to Administrative Office strictly between 10 am to 12 pm on a working day. Reporting late from leave will attract a similar fine as mentioned at Para 3 above. The same rule will apply on those, who take leave more than the authorised days.

8. Parents are allowed to meet and greet their wards on his birthday strictly between 6 pm to 7 pm. Prior intimation of visit to the school should be given to Administrative Office on the day of visit between 10 am to 5 pm. Parents can bring sweets, chocolates and preferably sapling for plantation.

9. Visiting hours to meet school authorities will be strictly between 11.30 am to 1.30 pm on working days.

10. Parents are requested to **take the results personally** on result day.

11. Senior Ramdandees should be **in possession of shaving kit (cartridge type only)**.

12. Eatables are NOT permitted. Parents can give maximum three (03), **80 gram** biscuit packets and **200 gram** dry fruits per month to their wards. Items found in excess to this scale will be confiscated and distributed amongst fellow cadets.

13. The school authorities **DO NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY UNTOWARD INCIDENT WHAT SO EVER** in case a Ramdandee **ABSCONDS** from school campus.

14. **Ramdandees leaving campus without permission will attract strict disciplinary action. Unauthorised absence from the school for more than 48 hours may lead to the expulsion of cadets.**

15. Using abusive language, arrogant behaviour with staff, breaking of school property, damaging furniture, physical violence with fellow cadets, unauthorised absence from school, leaving the premises without prior permission from competent authority will be construed as major breach of discipline and invite expulsion from school.

16. Electronic equipments and gadgets such as mobile phone, camera, i-pod, transistors, cash, undesirable magazine literature etc. are strictly prohibited in the school campus. Any cadet found in possession of any of the gadgets will be liable for a fine of Rs. 5000/- and strict disciplinary action will be initiated. The item will be confiscated and will not be returned under any circumstances to the Ramdandee or the parents.

17. Colouring of hair, use of gel, weird hairstyle, wearing of ear rings is strictly prohibited.

18. **No medicines are to be kept** with the ward. If necessary, the same should be handed over to Medical Assistant along with the Doctor's prescription.

19. Parents are requested to ensure that their ward is not pampered and not exposed to undesirable company, literature, food and audio visuals while they are on vacation.

20. Students who use spectacles must have at least two (2) sets with them. **Spectacles should have a thin (rim) frame of black colour only.**

21. The school uniform / kit listed at **Page No 15** will be issued in the first week of reporting. Ramdandees are expected to maintain the same in good condition. In case of damage or loss, the item will be issued on payment only from the store.

22. Items required to be brought by cadets from home are listed at **Page No 14.**

23. Schedule of activities given in the conspectus is **subject to change** if there is a requirement.



अभिभावकों के लिए मार्गदर्शिका

1) पालकों से निवेदन है कि वे कृपया दी गई तिथी अनुसार विद्यालय शुल्क जमा कराए। अन्यथा आपके पाल्य को प्रवेश से वंचित रहना पड़ेगा।

विद्यालय शुल्क की अंतिम तिथी:-

प्रथम किश्त - 01 अप्रैल 2025 से 10 अप्रैल 2025

द्वितीय किश्त - 05 जून 2025 से 22 जून 2025

तृतीय किश्त - 25 अक्टूबर 2025 से 01 नवंबर 2025

2) फीस विलंब से देने पर 100/- रु. प्रतिदिन अनुसार 2000/- रु. तक विलंब शुल्क लिया जाएगा। और उसके बाद आपके पाल्य को विद्यालय से निष्कासित किया जाएगा।

3) छात्रों को (आऊटपास के बाद) दी गई तिथी पर ही रिपोर्ट करना अनिवार्य होगा। विलंब से आनेवाले छात्रों को निम्न प्रकार का दण्ड अनुदेय होगा:

(अ) पहलीबार में विलंब शुल्क - पहले दिन के लिए 250/- रु. तथा उसके बाद रु. 500/- प्रतिदिन लिया जाएगा।

(ब) दूसरीबार में विलंब शुल्क 500/- रु. प्रतिदिन लिया जाएगा।

(क) तीसरीबार में विलंब शुल्क 500/- रु. प्रतिदिन तथा अनुशासनात्मक कार्रवाई की जाएगी।

4) आऊटपास के बाद **विलंब से आनेपर** प्रशासकिय कार्यालय में **सुबह 10 से शाम 5 बजे तक** रिपोर्ट करना होगा।

5) एक सत्र में छात्रों को तीन दिन का ही अवकाश दिया जाएगा। किसी पर्याप्त कारण के लिए प्रशासन के निर्देश पर ही छुट्टी दी जाएगी।

6) जिन पालकों ने (अपने पाल्य के लिए) पहले से ही छुट्टी ले रखी है, वे सोमवार से शुक्रवार शाम 3 से 5 बजे तक और शनिवार 12 से 2 बजे तक ही ले जाने की अनुमति रहेगी। इस समय के बाद ले जाने की अनुमति नहीं दी जाएगी।

7) अवकाश से आने के पश्चात छात्र प्रशासनिक कार्यालय में कार्यालयीन दिवस पर 10 से 12 बजे तक रिपोर्ट करेंगे। देर से रिपोर्टिंग करने पर उपरोक्त अनुच्छेद 3 में बताई गई दंड राशी जमा करनी होगी। यही नियम निर्धारित छुट्टी से अधिक छुट्टी लेने पर भी लागू होगा।

8) पालकगण अपने पाल्य के जन्मदिवस के अवसर पर निर्धारित समय शाम 6 बजे से 7 बजे तक ही मिल सकते हैं। मिलने की पूर्वसूचना प्रशासकिय कार्यालय में सुबह 10 से 5 बजे तक देनी होगी। वे अपने साथ मिठाई, चॉकलेट, और वृक्षारोपण के लिए पौधा ला सकते हैं।

9) विद्यालय के प्रशासकिय अधिकारियों से मिलने का समय कार्यालयीन दिवस में सुबह 11.30 से 1.30 बजे तक ही होगा।

10) पालकों से निवेदन है कि अपने पाल्य की प्रगति पुस्तक परिक्षा परिणाम के दिन स्वयं प्राप्त करें।

11) सिनीयर रामदंडी अपने साथ **शेविंग किट** अवश्य ले आएंगे। (Cartridge type only)

12) खाद्य सामग्री लाने की अनुमति नहीं दी जाएगी। पालकगण हर महिने में बिस्कीट 80 ग्राम और सूखे मेवे के 200 ग्राम के तीन पैकेट ही दे सकते हैं। इससे ज्यादा मात्रा में दी गई सामग्री अन्य कैंडेट्स को वितरित कर दी जाएगी।

13) बिना अनुमति के यदि छात्र विद्यालय परिसर से बाहर जाता है, तो उस पर अनुशासनात्मक कार्रवाई की जाएगी। बिना पूर्वसूचना के विद्यालय से 48 घंटे से ज्यादा अनुपस्थित होने पर उसे बिना किसी सूचना के विद्यालय से बाहर निकाला जाएगा।

14) बिना अनुमति के यदि छात्र विद्यालय परिसर से बाहर जाता है, तो उसके साथ घटनेवाली किसी भी अवांछित घटना की जिम्मेदारी स्कूल प्रशासन नहीं लेगी।

15) अशोभनीय वार्तालाप, स्कूल के कर्मचारियों के साथ दुर्व्यवहार, विद्यालय की संपत्ति की तोड़फोड़, अन्य छात्रों के साथ हिंसात्मक मारपीट, बिना कारण अनुपस्थिति एवं सक्षम प्राधिकारी से पूर्व अनुमति के बिना परिसर को छोड़ना इसे अनुशासन का बड़ा उल्लंघन माना जाएगा। जिसके लिये पाल्य को स्कूल से निष्कासित किया जाएगा।

16) विद्यालय में Mobile, Camera, I-Pod, Transistor तथा अन्य विद्युत उपकरण, नगद राशी, गैरजरूरी मॅगझीन, किताबें लाना वर्जित है। यदि ऐसी कोई भी वस्तु छात्रों के पास से प्राप्त होती है तो उसपर 5000/- रु तक जुर्माना और दंडात्मक कार्रवाई की जाएगी। प्राप्त की गई सभी चीजें जप्त की जाएंगी व वापस नहीं मिलेगी।

17) विद्यालय में बालों को रंगना, बालों पे जेल का उपयोग, कानों में कुंडल (बाली) पहनना तथा बालों को अजीब ढंग से बनाना मना है।

18) कृपया ध्यान रखें अपने पाल्य के साथ **किसी भी प्रकार की दवाई ना भेजें**। यदि दवाईयाँ आवश्यकतानुसार हैं तो कृपया Medical Assistant को सौंप दें और उसकी विस्तृत जानकारी दें, ताकि स्कूल Medical Assistant दवाईयाँ ठीक तरीके से पाल्य को दे सके और उनका अपने पास लेखा जोखा रखे।

19) अवकाश के दौरान ध्यान रखें की आपका पाल्य किसी भी बुरी संगत, अश्लिल हरकतें, असभ्य साहित्य, चित्र अथवा सिनेमा से दूर रहें।

20) जो छात्र "ऐनक" का उपयोग करते हैं वे कृपया अपने साथ 'दो ऐनक' लाएँ। ऐनक की फ्रेम काली रंग की होनी चाहिए।

21) पृष्ठ क्र. पर दी गयी विद्यालय में गणवेश/सामान संच; ज्ञापजद्ध विद्यालय में प्रवेश के समय पहले सत्याह में पाल्य को मिलेगी। छात्र अपनी वस्तुओं की देखभाल स्वयं करें। टूट-फूट या खो जाने पर उसे 'वस्तु भंडार' से उचित मूल्य देकर प्राप्त करना होगा।
